- Multiple inputs received for Firewise® cost database (including EDCFSC Chipping, Defensible Space and Hazardous Tree contractor costs)


## **BAD NEWS**

## RDSFSC CWPP INPUT

- Community Description
  - Rancho Del Sol (RDS) is a gated community in Camino, California consisting of 157 parcel owners with 138 residences and 19 vacant lots
  - RDS is located between US 50 to the north, Starkes Grade Road to the northeast, and Newtown Road / Snows Road to the southwest
  - RDS is a one-way in / one-way out subdivision located in a Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone identified in Cal Fire's Subdivision Review Program. Puerta Del Sol is the roadway that provides access to RDS
  - RDS has two emergency exits to the northeast, the Loma Del Norte to Lynx
     Trail exit and the Pasa Robles to Starkes Grade exit


## RDSFSC Fire Risk Assessment

- Rancho Del Sol is surrounded on its north and west sides by the North Fork of Weber Creek canyon. The canyon is heavily overgrown (photos below) and in desperate need of fuel reduction treatment. There are extensive dead and down trees and extremely heavy underbrush throughout the canyon next to the RDS community
- RDS interior roadways and emergency exits are narrow and surrounded by heavy brush and trees in many areas



Puerta Del Sol Identified One Way In One Way Out Access to RDS








## RDSFSC Recommended Top Priority Actions

- Fuel Reduction along North Fork of Weber Creek Canyon along ridgeline as depicted in current CWPP page 461 as "RD-1"
- Roadside clearance along RDS roadways and emergency exits



RD-1 Fuel Reduction Area from current CWPP Page 461



  - Pleasant Valley FSC and Pollock Pines FSC who originally identified this area no longer exist






